2014 HIGHLIGHTS

Newport Hospital & Health Services Foundation

- 2014 Released a new event for the Foundation. The ***Iron Sommelier & Brewmaster Event*** (held in the historic Beardmore Building of Priest River) offered guests the opportunity to taste gourmet food with “expertly” paired wines or microbrews.
- The popular ***Heart-to-Heart Tea Social*** welcomed Dr. Spangler of Spokane Cardiology to a summer crowd. Held in July, this year’s event focused on overall heart health.
- April’s ***Healthy Habits, Healthy Lives Wellness Fair*** ushered in the entire community for a day of health lectures, activities, and vendor booths. Two new bicycles were given away to two lucky children, and fun was had by all!
- Foundation friends, John and Jane Floyd, pledged John’s entire hiking season to raising funds for healthy kids in ***Hike-to-Health: Where’s John?***. John set out in April, and by September 19th, he had logged over 1,964 miles. His daily goal was to hike a marathon (26.2 miles) each day!
- The 7th Annual ***Fore! the Health of It Golf Tournament*** at StoneRidge Golf Course (Blanchard, ID) raised money for the Foundation’s ***Healthy Kids Snack Bag*** program.
- The 7th Annual ***Newport Autumn Bloom 5K/10K Fun Run*** welcomed serious and recreational runners and walkers from all over the Northwest. Four female 10K runners qualified for the coveted 2015 Bloomsday second seed placement.
- The 2014 ***Festival of Trees*** in December kicked off the 2015 fundraising focus at Sadie Halstead Middle School in Newport, WA. Daytime events included tree viewing, free Santa photos, kids’ crafts, cookie decorating, and festive entertainment. The Evening Social boasted a gourmet buffet, live music from *Scotia Road*, and the tree raffle. With 12 trees in all and many fabulous sponsors, the event grossed around \$15,500.

RIVER MOUNTAIN VILLAGE ASSISTED LIVING WALKING PATH...\$15,675

Constructed in 2008, this paved walking path is treasured by residents of River Mountain Village.

DEXA SCAN BONE DENSITY SCANNER...\$12,000

Purchased in 2009, this machine performs the most commonly used test for measuring bone mineral density. It is one of the most accurate ways to diagnosis Osteopenia or Osteoporosis.

GLIDESCOPE VIDEO LARYNGOSCOPE...\$10,000

This illuminated intubation device was purchased in 2010 and is currently used in our Surgery and Emergency Departments. This scope provides a consistently clear, real-time view of the airway and tube placement, enabling quick intubation.

DIGITAL MAMMOGRAPHY MACHINE...\$45,000

This state-of-the-art machine was purchased in 2011 and allows us to screen for early detection of breast cancer.

HEALTHY NEWPORT COMMUNITY WELLNESS INITIATIVE...\$3,395 (2012)...\$247 (2013)

In February of 2012, the Foundation partnered with Healthy Newport to host a community tea social with guest cardiologist, Dr. Lubbe. The Foundation also participated in other wellness events to promote healthy living in the community.

HEALTHY KIDS SNACK BAGS...\$4,353 (2012)...\$8,763 (2013)...\$26,655 (2014)

The NHHS Foundation recently adopted the Healthy Kids Snack Bags program in 2012. During that first year, the Foundation contributed over \$4,300 to provide healthy snacks to local school children at Stratton Elementary in Newport. By fall of 2013, the Foundation fulfilled its promise to the community and expanded deliveries to include the following communities of Cusick, WA; Oldtown, ID; Priest River, ID; and Newport, WA. 2013 Contributions totalled almost \$8,800. In 2014, the Foundation included snack deliveries to the Kalispel Career Training Center (KCTC), and continued with the five-school distribution area. Foundation events and specific grants from the Empire Health Foundation, Kalispel Tribe and the Priest River Community Foundation helped sustain the program for another year.



Healthy Kids Snack Bags - Volunteers have a great time packing the weekly snack bags. In 2013, deliveries were sent to Cusick, Newport, Priest River (ID), and Oldtown (ID). 2014 included deliveries to Priest Lake and KCTC.
